

The SKA Rating System

Ska Rating is a RICS-led and owned environmental assessment method, benchmark and standard for non-domestic fit outs. It helps landlords and tenants assess fit out projects against a set of sustainability good practice criteria, known as 'Good Practice Measures' (GPM).

Its main features are:

- Project driven: labels fit out projects irrespective of base building
- A free online tool: to help organisations achieve more sustainable fit outs (Businesses only pay if they want formal certification)
- Flexible scoping: the tool only measures what is within the specific project's scope

The system comprises over 100 good practice measures across energy & CO2, waste, water pollution, transport, **materials** and wellbeing.

Each good practice measure is outlined in a data sheet explaining the criteria that need to be achieved, including the rationale behind the measure and guidance on how to achieve the Ska rating.

The principle **materials** listed in the Ska Rating for which Forza would be asked to supply are as follows:
